CLUB RULES

Membership is open to all those interested in Metal Detecting and willing to assist the Club.

There is a 3 month probationary period for new members.

Members only detect at Club Digs with a valid NCMD membership.

There is no detecting on Club sites at any time other than at an official Club Dig day.

Always get permission before detecting on private land or beaches.

Abide by the Code of Conduct of FID/NCMD

Always follow the Countryside Code.

Follow the Treasure Act 1996.

Report all finds suspected of being over 300 years old to your FLO.

Remove all your litter from the site.

Do not re-bury unwanted finds.

Re-fill your holes neatly and flat, even on beaches.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Do not trespass.

We recommend you obtain a signed Search Agreement from the landowner when searching privately.

Never take a Metal Detector near Scheduled Monuments or Sites of Special Scientific Interest.

Report all finds to the Club on Club Dig Days.

Do not frighten animals or disturb nesting birds. Do not damage trees, fences or wild flowers.

Close all gates behind you.

Report any dead, injured or escaped animals to the farmer/landowner immediately.

Leave the land as you found it. Fill all holes carefully, leaving little or no trace of your dig.

Remove all litter and trash finds from the land and dispose of it properly.

Report all finds suspected of being over 300 years old to the PAS FLO.

Report live ammunition or human remains to the Police and landowner immediately.

Mark it or fence it off, do not disturb the area.
